At the outset, the Chairman welcomed the members. Thereafter following agenda were discussed and resolved.

Agenda Item No. 1: To consider the revised fee structure of various courses for academic session 2015-16 (Deferred Item of 48th meeting)

The fee structure for the academic session 2015-16 was revised and the same was placed in the 48th meeting of Academic placed however, it was deferred for the next meeting of Academic Council. The same is again placed as **Annexure-A** for consideration and approval.

RESOLUTION

The discussed fee structure as proposed by DSW after discussion with students and approved the same after certain modification as per Annexure A.

Agenda Item No. 2: To discuss the modality of implementation of Choice Based Credit System (CBCS)

UGC vide its letter dated 12.11.2014 requested this University to introduce uniform Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS) for which guidelines formulated by UGC are available at UGC's website. Accordingly, vide circular dated 17.11.2014, all Deans/Heads of respective departments/schools were requested to submit their comments, if any, after going through the said guidelines and the matter was placed before the Academic Council for its consideration in the 45th meeting held on 24.11.2014. It was resolved to adopt the UGC guidelines in toto and necessary amendments in the syllabus of the courses be made accordingly.

Now, the matter is placed before the Academic Council for discussing the modality of implementation of the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS).

RESOLUTION

The members discussed the modalities of Choice Based Credit System and resolved that credit should be calculated on the basis of 70:30 (70% weightage to end-semester and 30% weightage to sessionals) and each department as per earlier decision will have to follow CBCS as proposed by UGC.

Agenda Item No. 3: To review the running of M.Phil courses and payment of fellowship to M.Phil. students.

The University has already started M.Phil. courses and number of students are enrolled in these courses, however, no payment of fellowship is being made to the students of M.Phil. The matter is placed before the Academic Council to review the running of M.Phil. courses and also the payment of fellowship to M.Phil. students.

RESOLUTION

It was resolved to phase-out M.Phil. courses, however, if any department intends to run the same, it can continue as a regular course without any financial liabilities on the University. The University ~~will~~^{may} approach UGC for any funding provided for the fellowship and regular faculty.


OTHER ITEMS
