As per recommendation of DRC no student has been admitted in Ph.D. (Computer Science) programme even after counselling. Sri Surendra Kumar also represented his case before National Commission in SC/ST (Both state and national level) for getting admission in Ph.D. (Computer Science) programme. RESOLUTION

Controller of Examination has explained before the Academic Council that subject of the Ph.D. programme has not been mentioned in Ph.D. degree certificates in all courses/subjects of the University. Therefore, amendment in the Ph.D. degree certificate with inclusion cannot be considered. Hence Academic Council was resolved that inclusion of subject in Ph.D. degree certificate cannot be done.

Table Agenda Item No. T7: The case of Ms. Meenakshi for grant of permission for admission counselling in full time three year undergraduate programme of Bachelor of vocational studies in live stock production and management.

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Ms. Meenakshi has not appeared in the entrance examination in October 2015, however candidate has submitted the examination fee as reported by departmental admission committee. Now candidate is requesting for allowing her to participate in the counseling as reported by admission committee. However date of counseling was 04.11.2015 which is already expired. The department also inform that 15 seats in open category and 25 seats in reserve category are vacant. Therefore another counseling was proposed by admission committee on 30.11.2015 as per the academic ordinance section 5(xx)5(xxi) and 27 (1)(a) no student shall be eligible for admission to any under graduate or post graduate course of study in the University unless he/she has passed the examination or examination prescribed by the University for admission to the concerned course or courses (copy of ordinance is placed at **Annexure-G**). Matter is placed before Academic Council for direction/order on the issue.

The matter is placed for consideration and recommendation.

RESOLUTION

The case of Ms. Meenakshi for grant of permission for admission in B.Voc Course cannot be approved as it is a violation of rules. Hence Academic Council rejected the case.

In this regard the list of gold medal finalized by the Chairman Gold Medal Committee (Sixth Convocation Committee) is placed that **Annexure-H**


