At the outset, the Chairman welcomed all the members and thereafter the following agenda were discussed and resolved:-

**Agenda Item 01:** To consider the establishment of Extension (Satellite) campus of BBAU in IIIT, Amethi for running vocational courses.

To cater to the much needed academic requirement of the adjoining areas in U.P. and neighboring States. Under section 5(xii) of BBAU Act, the University is empowered to establish campuses, special centres, specialized laboratories or other units for research and instruction as are, in the opinion of the University, necessary for the furtherance of its objects.

The matter is placed for kind consideration and approval.

#### Resolution

The Academic Council resolved to approve the proposal of the establishment of Extension (Satellite) campus of BBAU at IIIT, Amethi, in principle.

The Council was of the view that a campus can be established outside Lucknow as per Section 5(xii) of the BBAU Act, 1994.

Further, it is resolved that a team under the chairmanship Prof. R.P. Singh and Prof. Sunita Mishra, Prof. R.B. Ram, Prof. Ripu Sudan Singh, Prof. Priti Saxena/Prof. Sudarshan Verma, Prof. Vipin Saxena, Prof. Kamal Jaiswal, Prof. Manish Kumar Verma, Dr. M.S. Khan, Executive Engineer as Members and Shri B.K. Kashyap as Convener will visit Amethi in this regard. The team will submit its report to Prof. N.M.P. Verma who will further prepare DPR in consultation with Prof. R.P. Singh, Prof. R.B. Ram and Finance Officer.

The detailed Project Report will include the requirements related to teaching, non-teaching and infrastructure alongwith financial implications etc. and submit the same to the Vice Chancellor on or before 16.05.2016 so that the same may be placed before the Board of Management in its ensuing meeting.

**Agenda Item 02:** To consider the Minutes of the Examination Committee held on 19.04.2016.

**Agenda Item 04:** To consider the matter of two students from M.Sc. Forensic Science and criminology (II<sup>nd</sup> Semester) due to non paid of semester fees.

The In-charge M.Sc. Forensic Science and Criminology has informed that two students from MFSC namely Miss Girisha Chowdhary and Mr. Shiv Nandan from IInd Semester, Batch 2015-17 were given admission on zero fee basis. However, recently they have informed the Department that their SC/ST scholarship from social welfare Department has not been sanctioned due to some technical reason. As such, the Department is not in a position to forward their examination forms from the current academic year exams, which are scheduled to be held from 13.05.2016. Since the whole Academic Year is about to end and M.Sc. Forensic Science and Criminology is a self finance programme, the Department is not in a position to grant/recommend any further extension in the date by which these students may deposit their dues.

The comments of SC/ST cell according status report in respect of Shri Shiv Nandan mentioned that his case is under suspect data in scrutiny. Not verified/digitally signed by DWO. In his case there are some chances he may get his fellowship

The matter is placed for kind consideration.

#### Resolution

The Academic Council resolved to allow all such students to appear in the end semester examination of May, 2016 at their own risk. However, their admission to III semester shall be subject to finalization of the issue. It is also resolved to take an undertaking to this effect from students.

**Table Agenda Item 01:** To consider the starting new academic programs each in *Urdu and Sanskrit.* 

The Meeting of the committee to explore the possibility of starting new academic programs each in Urdu and Sanskrit was held on 03.05.2016 at 3:00 pm in the office chamber of the chairman.

The Committee resolved to recommend for starting, to begin with, two programs namely, (i) a certificate course in Urdu language and (ii) a diploma in Urdu translation.

The committee further recommends that an M.A. program in Sanskrit may also be started from the next academic year in a manner described above for Urdu.

**Table Agenda Item No. 03:** To consider the matter of Ms. Richa Arya, Research Scholar, Department of Environmental Science for special extension of thesis submission.

Research Scholar Ms. Richa Arya Department of Environmental Science was admitted on 26.08.2009 in Ph.D. programme. She is working under Prof. D.P. Singh at this time. She has taken extension from 26.08.2013 to 25.08.2014 (i.e. one year) as per Ph.D. ordinance. Her tenure (Ph.D.) was completed five years on 25.08.2014. The matter has been put up in the 42<sup>nd</sup> meeting of Academic Council as a special case and it was resolved that extend the date of thesis submission up to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2014. Further, due to some adverse circumstances, she has not submitted her thesis in extended period. Therefore, the applicant again requested to give another special extension for thesis submission as recommended by her supervisor.
